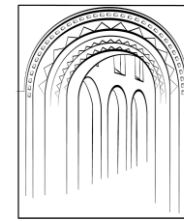

Roof repairs have begun in the North Aisle and will continue after that in the South Aisle, ending in November, we hope. When this phase is finished the entire medieval roof will have been restored in the past seven years. I think we might deserve a little celebration when we get there. As I write, there is no scaffolding inside the Cathedral, yet, and it is not possible to reckon how much disruption there might be to e.g. the use of the Crindau altar. But the architect and contractor are aiming to keep disruption to a minimum.
