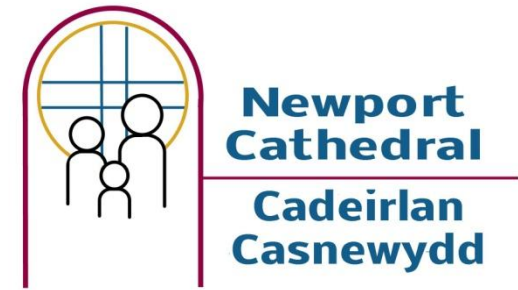

Election of a new Bishop of Monmouth:
