The top of the tower offers breathtaking panoramic views of Newport and the surrounding hills. However, there are **113 spiral steps** to the tower roof. The headroom is limited, the climb is strenuous and **the steps on the inside of the spiral are very narrow.**

The climb is not suitable for those who are:

Elderly or infirm

Suffer from vertigo or claustrophobia.

Suffer from heart or respiratory disorders.

Any condition affecting fitness or mobility.

Under guidance from our insurers, access will not be permitted to:

Children under the age of 8yrs.

(Children between 8-16yrs must be accompanied by a responsible adult)

Adults aged 80+ yrs.

Anyone who is perceived to be under the influence of alcohol or drugs.

Those who are pregnant or suffer from heart disorders.

Health and Safety Guidelines:

The stairway is steep and narrow, some steps are uneven and there are sections without a hand rail. The final doorway to the roof is low. The rope handrail is to be used at all times, especially when coming back down the stairs and care is to be taken to walk on the wider side of the step next to the hand rail.

The maximum number of guests on any tour is **6**

Bulky bags and equipment must be left at ground level
