## **Choral Evensong on Wednesdays**

Choral Evensong resumes this Wednesday, 22<sup>nd</sup> April at 6.15pm. Do come along and enjoy an oasis of beautiful music, prayers and readings every Wednesday in term time.

**Volunteers and Safeguarding:** Here at Newport Cathedral, our commitment to Safeguarding is a priority and we work hard to ensure that the Cathedral is both a safe and welcoming space for all. The Church in Wales (CinW) currently has an enhanced focus on Safeguarding in the Church, including the safe recruitment of volunteers.

Nearly all volunteers have now completed at least Module A of the CinW safeguarding training and, where required, undertaken a check with the Disclosure and Barring Service (DBS). The next step, over the coming weeks, is for all volunteers to be provided with a role description for each role they undertake, a volunteer handbook and an emergency contact card.

There will also be a volunteer agreement form to sign and return to one of the wardens or the office by Sunday 3<sup>rd</sup> May. Please note that, unfortunately, if you don't return the signed form by this date, your volunteering will have to be paused until we receive it. Thank you for your understanding with this matter.
